Albania:
Community Centres

Moldova

Pray for the health of the workers and all the vulnerable elderly and children who have suffered the effects of the winter flu.

Ask God to release all the financial support needed to ensure we run the best summer camps we can.

Albania:
Vocational Training

Pray for those who are able to benefit from these courses. Pray also that they'll receive valuable opportunities for future paid employment – so necessary in Albania.

Day 5
Puppet ministry

This is a fruitful ministry and so crucial. Praise God for those who are called and skilled enough to do it. They present the gospel in a fresh way.

Day 8
Sharing Jesus with others

Pray for more workers to be found in all the countries where Mission Without Borders works. The need is great and we are seeing many opportunities for spreading the gospel.

Bulgaria

A good partnership exists between most of the churches in the areas where we work. Give thanks for this and continue to pray for its continuation.

Moldova: Child Rescue International

Pray for the children who are suffering because their parents have no paid employment. Around 30,000 children are estimated to have parents who have left to find work in another country.



Day 6
Bosnia

Pray for the war trial at the Hague of Radovan Karadzic. Many are still suffering and confused. Pray that this broken nation will soon be able to find some resolution and justice.

Day 9
Bulgaria

Pray for Sarkis, the Bulgarian manager, as he seeks to expand MWB's work. Pray for regular, ongoing support for poor families.

Day 13
Moldova

The new parliament was elected recently, including some believers. As the new government begins, it offers new possibilities. But pray for real wisdom to move out of Moldova's communist legacy.

Day 16
Romania:
Community Centres

This vital work still requires support. Many people rely upon churches to provide food to them on a regular basis.

Day 19
Ukraine:
Sponsor's trip

Ask God to bless this one-week trip to Ukraine in October. May it prove to be an inspiring time for those travelling. Pray for the planning arrangements.

Day 3
Albania: F2F

Pray for those families who are suffering real hardship. Economic conditions are harsh, putting pressure on the family unit.

Community Centres

These centres provide much needed practical help for the elderly in particular. These are based at Glamoc and Zenica.

Feeding Centres

Continue to uphold the volunteers who run the feeding centres. Pray that as they witness God's love, the recipients will find the Saviour.

Christian Radio

Continue to pray for the 'Children's Christian Radio'. Regular programmes are listened to by hundreds of thousands, and the feedback we receive is very encouraging.

Give thanks for our National Manager, Mykola Bogdanets' recovery from pneumonia. Remember the staff of 40 who work alongside him that they will be enabled to serve God faithfully.

In our Rivne office we have 4 full time and 10 volunteer staff members. Many visit on a daily basis to receive spiritual and emotional support. Pray for the staff to be able to respond to all sorts of issues.
