
Moldova

Bosnia-Herzegovina

While we are still recovering from the impact of COVID-19, the war has brought about a steep increase in prices, with some groceries now almost double in price. With wages remaining the same, this is detrimental for vulnerable families with limited means. There is a high influx of refugees, and the administration needs to be facilitated for them to obtain refugee status and health care. Please pray for politicians, their leadership, wisdom, and facilitation of the administration for refugees.

13/14

Many of our families suffer from PTSD because of the Bosnian war. The news of the war in Ukraine reawakens old memories, fears, and unrest. Please join us in prayer for the people who went through the Bosnian war, that God may give them peace, comfort, and hope.

15/16

Please continue to pray for Dražana, our cook in the Zenica Soup Kitchen. She is undergoing chemotherapy for colon cancer.

Bosnia-Herzegovina

17/18

Please join us in praising the Lord for the positive changes in families and progress toward a sustainable future. Many families have become self-sufficient in the last year. Please pray for them that they will continue in their faith and remember that their help comes from God.

Family R from Neamt county has a difficult situation. The mother has had some medical problems which worsened while giving birth to her youngest child [1 year ago]. Since then, she cannot breathe without an oxygen machine. There are 3 children in the family, and the eldest girl, who is almost 10 years old, had to abandon school to look after her mother and the house. We are supporting the family with regular food deliveries and other necessities. Please pray for the family, the mother's health, and the eldest child's reintegration into school.
